# **JUMPING COMMENCING AT 8.30 AM PROMPTLY - INDOORS**

#### **CLASS 1 - CLEAR ROUND**

Jumps 30cms may be led or assisted. £5.00 per round payable in cash on the day

# **CLASS 2 - STARTING AT 9AM - 30CMS**

Jumps approximately 30cms in the first round. Single phase competition. Combinations in this class may not compete in classes 6 or 7. May be led or assisted

# **CLASS 3 - 35CMS PAIRS**

Jumps approximately 35cms in the first round. Single phase competition. Combinations in this class may not compete in classes 6 or 7. May be led or assisted

#### **CLASS 4 - 40CMS**

Jumps approximately 40cms in the first round. Single phase competition Combinations in this class may not compete in classes 6 or 7. May be led or assisted

# **CLASS 5 - 40CMS HORSE AND HOUND**

Jumps approximately 40cms in the first round. Single phase competition.

#### **CLASS 6 - 50CMS**

Jumps approximately 50cms in the first round. Single phase competition

#### **CLASS 7 - 60CMS**

Jumps approximately 60cms in the first round. Single phase competition

# **CLASS 8 - 65CMS PAIRS**

Jumps approximately 65cms in the first round. Single phase competition.

# **CLASS 9 - 70CMS**

Jumps approximately 70cms in the first round. Single phase competition.

# **CLASS 10 - 80CMS**

Jumps approximately 80cms in the first round. Single phase competition.

# **CLASS 11 - PUISSANCE - STARTING AT 80CMS**

There will be a warm up fence followed by an oxer and then the "puissance" fence. Those who jump clear will go forward to the next round where the fences will be raised in increments with a total of four rounds.

Entry Fees:

All classes £15.00 per rider First Aid £4.00 per rider

Closing date for entries is Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2023 Classes will be restricted and will close as soon as they are full. Please note that entries often close before the closing show date.

All classes will be allocated times and numbers that will be available to view on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> October 2023 at horse events. P lease provide your own number bib or bridle number.

# **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

It is a condition of entry that ALL droppings are cleared up, and that no lorry/trailer is cleaned out in the car park area. It is forbidden for vehicles or horses to encroach on any grass area. No smoking is allowed inside or outside the indoor arena area.

Visiting members of the public are restricted to the hired riding area, car park and toilet facilities. Please respect these rules set by BCA who have kindly allowed us to hold this event.

This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Show Jumping rules 2023 modified where applicable.

The decision of the Judges and Organisers is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse any entry without stating a reason.

In the event of cancellation, the entry fees, less an administration fee will be refunded.

It is regretted that entry fees can only be refunded after the closing date on production of a medical or veterinary certificate within three days of the competition date.

**LEGAL LIABILITY** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

**HEALTH AND SAFETY.** The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The SOH(S) Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.

Correct riding attire must be worn at all times when mounted. Body protectors are recommended for Show Jumping.

A protective helmet manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed must be worn. PAS 015: 2011\* with BSI Kitemark, VG1 with BSI Kitemark, Snell E2016\* onwards with the official Snell label and number, ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with the SEI mark, AS/NZS 3838, 2006 onwards. (2023 pink tag). Can be done on the day at the Secretary's Office, please bring your hat to be checked and tagged before competing.

# Whip rules

Riders may not hit their horse/ pony before the start of the course and may be eliminated for doing so at the Judge's discretion. A whip, if carried, must be held in the hand by the handle with the handle at the top. The whip must be "padded" and comply with the current British Show Jumping rule (BS Members Handbook, full wording is available to view online at www.britishshowjumping.co.uk).

Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the organiser within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £20, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

In the interests of safety, dogs MUST be kept on leads at all times and NO STALLIONS except by prior permission.
