40cm Area 12 PC Showjumping Championship 1 st Round (pre-qualified competitors only) Entry fee £32.00 Rosettes to 6th place for teams and individuals	1	This competition will run as two rounds. Both rounds will be in the indoor arena. Scores from both rounds will be added together to get the final scores. The first round is not timed.12 years and under. May be assisted but not led.
40cm Lantern Novice Stakes - Open Entry fee £20.00 Rosettes to 10th place. (Incorporating Champs 2 nd round)	2	Single phase. Riders not to have competed at 60cm or above and cannot enter classes at 60cm or above. 12 years and under. May be assisted and/or led (except for Champs rounds – assisted only)
50cm Pumpkin Stakes - Open Entry fee £20.00 Rosettes to 10th place. (Incorporating Champs 2 nd round)	3	Single Phase. Combination not to have competed at 70cm or above and cannot enter classes at 70cm or above. May be assisted and/or led (except for Champs classes – no assistance permitted)
60cm Monster Stakes - Open Entry fee £20.00 Rosettes to 10th place. (Incorporating Champs 2 nd round)	4	Single Phase. May be assisted but not led (except for Champs classes – no assistance permitted)
70cm Ghost Stakes - Open Entry fee £20.00 Rosettes to 10th place. (Incorporating Champs 2 nd round)	5	Single Phase.
80cm Scary Open - Open Entry fee £20.00 Rosettes to 10th place.	6	Single phase.

PLEASE NOTE - If you have entered a Championship Class you CANNOT enter the Open Class at the same height. E.g. If you enter the 60 Champs Class, you cannot enter the 60cm Open. However, you can enter the 50cm Open, the 60cm Pairs, or a 70cm Class.

Ring 2 - Outdoor		
50cm Area 12 PC Showjumping Championship (pre-qualified competitors only) 1 st round. Entry fee £32.00 Rosettes to 6th place for teams and individuals	7	This competition will run as two rounds. The first round will be outdoor and not timed, the second round will be indoor and single phase. Scores from both rounds will be added together to get the final scores. 12 years and under.
60cm Area 12 PC Showjumping Championship (pre-qualified competitors only) 1 st round. Entry fee £32.00 Rosettes to 6th place for teams and individuals	8	This competition will run as two rounds. The first round will be outdoor and not timed, the second round will be indoor and single phase. Scores from both rounds will be added together to get the final scores.
65cm Hocus Pocus Pairs - Open Entry Fee £40 per pair Rosettes to 10 th place.	9	The first rider completes the course, followed by the second rider who then jumps the same course. Both rounds are timed.
70cm Area 12 PC Showjumping Championship (pre-qualified competitors only) 1 st round. Entry fee £32.00 Rosettes to 6th place for teams and individuals	10	This competition will run as two rounds. The first round will be outdoor and not timed, the second round will be indoor and single phase. Scores from both rounds will be added together to get the final scores.
70cm Spooky Ride & Obstacle Fun Run - Open Entry fee £20.00 Rosettes to 10th place.	11	Ride a course of fences and then have a go at the on-foot fun obstacle/skills course. Either the rider can jump off, and go around the on-foot course, or a second person can do this part. A fun class open to all competitors. Everything will be explained and demonstrated as part of the course walk.

Rosettes will be awarded for the best Fancy Dress in each **Open** Class including Pairs and Ride/Run. (All Open classes are highlighted in green). Fancy Dress must be safe for rider and pony – colours can be different to general rules, but other safety rules will still apply.

Rosettes will also be awarded by stewards/judges for those competitors who are seen to demonstrate the Pony Club values. These values are Togetherness, Empathy, Respect and Learning.

Information for SJ Championship Classes

Championship Classes - The 40cms, 50cms, 60cms and 70cms Championship Classes are for Pony Club Members who have pre-qualified and registered, from Area 12 only. Combinations can enter up to two championship classes, and you can enter any of the other open classes.

First Round - This will be at the qualified height, it will not be timed and will run in the outdoor arena (except for 40cm where both rounds are in the indoor arena).

Second Round – This will run in the indoor arena and will be in the same running order as the first round. This will be single phase. (except for 40cm where both rounds are in the indoor arena).

Entering - Riders enter the relevant class as individuals. When asked for 'Team' info please enter the name of your branch. You will be placed into a team by your DC, or into a mixed branch team if there are less than 3 entered in your branch.

Team Scoring – Teams are made up of 3 or 4 riders. The best 3 scores in the first round will be added to the best 3 scores in the 2nd round to obtain the final result. If equality of faults, the times of the competitors with the best 3 scores in the 2^{nd} round will be used.

Individual Scoring - Your score will count for both your team, and for you as an individual - so two chances to get placed.

Elimination - Eliminated teams will not be able to enter the 2nd round. However, non-eliminated team members may continue into the 2nd round as individuals. A team member eliminated in the 1st round may still jump for their team in the 2nd round provided that the team as a whole was not eliminated (i.e. 3 members not eliminated).

Assistance - No assistance may be given in any of the Championship classes except the 40cm (no leading).

Course Walks - There will be a course walk at the start of each class. They may also be a later second course walk if deemed necessary.

Presentations - Will be unmounted at the Championships banner.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

 The decision of the Judges and Stewards is final. Classes judged according to Pony Club rules except where otherwise stated. Entry is taken as acceptance of these rules. PC dress and saddlery rules apply to all Championship classes. PC or BS dress and saddlery rules apply to Open classes.

2. No entry will be refunded after the closing date for any reason whatsoever.

3. All horses and ponies must be 4 years or over. The Judges reserve the right to disqualify any rider they consider to be 'under horsed'.

4. Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the incident and a deposit of £30 must be lodged. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is sustained.

5. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

6. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

7. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Old Berkeley Hunt (South) Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.

8. Entries close Wednesday 23rd October 2024. Championship classes close on 14th October.

9. Due to limited space, horses/ponies cannot be tied to lorries/trailers.

10. Please DO NOT leave any muck or rubbish in the lorry parks.

11. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. Dogs only permitted in the lorry park and NOT at the arenas.

12. Riders must only walk between the parking area and rings.
