



## Courses on Schools 14-16 programme - 25/26



### Land Based\*\* - BCA

*Gateway L1 Certificate (1 Year) Extended Cert (2 Years) in Vocational studies - Land Based Horticulture*

A combination of Horticulture, Countryside and Conservation specialisms. Students work on projects and activities across the estate for example on tree planting, fencing, bulb planting, growing from seed and maintaining areas of the estate such as our lake.

### Environmental Studies\*\* - BCA

*Gateway L1 Certificate (1 year) Ext Cert 2 years in Vocational Studies*

This course will consist of elements made up from a combination of curriculum areas over 2 years. For example - Studying Soil and Crops, Caring for Animals (feeding & grooming), Organic Horticulture, Understanding Animals and Identifying and Controlling Common Pests. Please note a one year course to achieve the Certificate will not cover all the areas stated above.

### Animal Care\*\* - BCA

*Gateway L1 Certificate (1 Year) Extended Cert (2 Years) in Vocational studies - Animal Care*

Animal Care specialism. Which is about working with and understanding animals, how to care for them, students work with a variety of animals from rabbits, sheep, goats and ferrets to those on our zoo courtyard such as monkeys, meerkats and racoons and spiders, snakes, frogs and insects in our exotics house.

### Animal Care\*\* **Slough & Langley group** - Bussed to BCA.

*Gateway L1 Certificate (1 Year) Extended Cert (2 Years) in Vocational studies - Animal Care*

Animal Care specialism. Which is about working with and understanding animals, how to care for them, students work with a variety of animals from rabbits, sheep, goats and ferrets to those on our zoo courtyard such as monkeys, meerkats and racoons and spiders, snakes, frogs and insects in our exotics house.

Students will be taken by minibus after registration at Langley College to BCA to use their facilities and then returned to Langley before the end of the day at 3pm for collection.

### Agriculture\*\* - BCA

*Gateway L1 Certificate (1 Year) Extended Cert (2 Years) in Vocational studies - Agriculture*

Agriculture will involve working with our goats, pigs, chickens, cattle and sheep including lambing. You will also learn about arable farming and learn about the crops grown on campus.

**Wednesdays or Thursdays**

### Equine - BCA

*City & Guilds L1 Cert (1 Year), L1 Diploma (2 Year) in Land Based - Horse Care*

Students will study health and safety and maintaining the health of horses as part of the course alongside practical horse care and stable management. Students will need to pass a riding assessment (they will need to be able to walk, trot & canter confidently in a group, as well as they need to be able to sit in a balanced position for Walk, Trot & Canter. They must also be able to steer in all 3 positions and meet the weight limit to be considered for this course. Due to the nature of the course there is an additional termly charge of £75. Yr11 has a mandatory Work Placement element.

**Please Note that students also need to be studying GCSE Maths & English if they are looking to progress onto Post 16 Level 2.**

**Tuesdays or Wednesdays**

### **Motor Vehicle \*\* - BCA or Slough & Langley**

*Gateway Level 1 Award (1 Year) Cert (2 Years) in Motor Vehicle Services*

Combination of theory and practical carried out in our fully equipped workshops. Working on both petrol and diesel vehicles and electric and hybrid vehicles.

### **Sport, Fitness and Active Leisure - BCA or Slough & Langley**

*Gateway L1 Award (1 Year) Cert (2 Years) in Sport, Fitness & Active Leisure*

This is a combination of different sports/activities such as Boulderling, Football, High Ropes, Badminton, Team Games, Beginners kayaking, Boxing, Fitness and Circuits (please note these may vary as the timetable is subject to changes) There is an additional termly charge of £65 to support with the numerous offsite activities the group take part in.

**Tuesdays or Thursdays**

### **Child Care\*\* - BCA**

*Gateway L1 Award (1 Year) Cert (2 Years) in Childcare*

Which involves studying units that look at how children learn and play, how to provide them with a safe and healthy environment, children's rights and responsibility, healthy children's diets etc. Working in college and also the opportunity for off site visits.

### **Hair & Beauty - Slough & Langley**

*City & Guilds Level 1 Certificate in and Introduction to the Hair & Beauty Sector*

The course will involve studying the following units Health & Safety, a professional image in a salon, skin care, nail art, manicure & pedicure. Also for Hair; Health & safety, working with others, reception duties shampooing/conditioning, plaiting & twisting hair and styling women's hair. Treatments will be carried out on each other so students will need to be comfortable with this.

Students will be taken by minibus after registration at BCA Schools to Langley College to use their facilities and then returned to BCA before the end of the day at 3pm for collection. Please Note: **The Hair/Beauty uniform and kits will need to be purchased as they are a mandatory requirement for assessments.**

**Thursdays (Hair) Fridays (Beauty)**

### **Vocational Studies Group A\*\* - BCA**

*Gateway L1 Certificate (1 year) Ext Cert 2 years in Vocational Studies*

This course will consist of elements made up from a combination of curriculum areas over 2 years. For example - Landbased (garden habitats, planting in a container) Environmental Studies (environmental awareness), Sport and Leisure (recognise sport and leisure opportunities, review sport and leisure activity), Animal Care (understanding animals), Hospitality (sustainability, menu planning, basic food preparation and cooking, customer service skills, food hygiene and safety)

### **Vocational Studies Group B\*\* - Slough & Langley**

*Gateway L1 Certificate (1 year) Ext Cert 2 years in Vocational Studies*

This course will consist of elements made up from a combination of curriculum areas over 2 years. For example - Business including Understanding Social Media for Business, Using Presentation Software and Conduct at Work.

Travel and Tourism including Travel and Tourism Destinations UK and Worldwide, Planning Trips to Local Visitor Attractions and Customer Service within the industry.

## **ESOL \*\* - Slough & Langley**

*Gateway L1 Award (1 Year) Cert (2 Years) in ESOL Skills for Life (Speaking and Listening)*

This course will consist of both speaking and listening elements linked to the ESOL Core Curriculum - This will enable the learner to be able to listen and understand conversations; be able to take part in discussions/conversations; be able to follow and give instructions and provide information.

## **Building and Construction\*\* - Slough & Langley**

*Gateway L1 Award (1 year) Cert (2 years) in Building and Construction*

The course is a multi-trade qualification with the opportunities to study units in Carpentry, Electrics and Plumbing.

Students will be taken by minibus after registration at BCA Schools to Langley College to use their facilities and then returned to BCA before the end of the day at 3pm for collection.
