Stationery

You will need to supply your own personal stationery. This will be used for theory and also in rehearsal time. We suggest the following:

- A notepad - for all thoughts and ideas (we suggest buying a multi pack as you may want to change these from project to project.)
- Pens - these can be black or blue.
- Pencils - for rough notes and also for marking in your scripts.
- Highlighters - to highlight any important information or lines in scripts.
- An A4 ring binder with plastic wallets - this will be where you store your scripts and any handouts you may be given.
- A rubber - for any mistakes!
- A water bottle - there are plenty of water fountains situated around the college.
- A pencil case - for all of the above stationery.

Throughout the course you may choose to do your work digitally. Whilst there are computers at college, you may wish to bring in your own laptop/tablet etc.

Uniform

You are required to wear **all black clothing** during your time at college. Clothing may be branded however we ask that you have one set of non branded blacks for performances.



You will need comfortable rehearsal wear and trainers for workshop and rehearsal days. This can include but is not limited to the following;

- Leggings
- Tracksuit bottoms
- Leotards
- Dance shorts and dance tights (girls)
- Shorts
- T shirts
- Black or nude underwear (for performances)
- A sports bra
- Trainers (Black jazz shoes are also handy if you have them)
- Black character shoes (for girls)
- Black smart shoes (for boys)
